Lessons and Rehearsals will again be offered for the **2010-2011** school year. Lessons take place during the school day on a rotation so kids are not missing the same part of the day. Schedule is flexible and geared around the students needs. Band rehearsals are held after school. The participating schools come together for various performances.

Who can join? Students in 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th or 8th grade with any level of experience.

What instruments are taught? Traditional band instruments: flute, oboe, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, horn, trombone, baritone, and concert percussion. This is a great chance for any student whether you have no experience, have had some lessons and want to supplement your current learning, or even if you play one instrument already and want to learn a new one.

What will it cost? Yearly fee is \$350.00. This does not include the rental fee for your instrument. Instruments can be rented from your local music store. It does include any sheet music, lesson books or supplementary materials that will be needed. Various payment options are available.
