The Christ King Alumni Development committee is pleased to announce this year's contribution to Christ King School from its Annual Fund. As you know, tuition alone does not cover the full cost to educate a Christ King student. The Annual Fund helps to bridge that gap. As always, we are sincerely grateful for the funds that have been generously given by our Alumni family and by our current parents. The Annual Fund will support Christ King School in 2012 in the following ways:

1. \$1,050 for materials for the Art program, funding 50% of the 2012/2013 budget
2. \$350 for the Music program, funding 50% of the 2012/2013 budget
3. \$3,000 to upgrade 1/3 of the computers in our computer lab

Christ King's Principal, Greg Meuler, is very grateful for the contributions from the school's alumni and parents. "As the principal, I want to tell you how much I and the faculty appreciate this financial help. We are so proud that we are able to maintain a full program in **Art and Music and Computer Education** (along with Spanish and Physical Education!).
