### **Poverty and Justice**

*“What does the Lord require of you?*

*To act justly, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with your God” (Micah 6:8).*

Generations of Faith continues on October 10 at 5:30 PM and October 12 at 5:30 PM. Our next sessions focus on the first step of the **ART** process (**A**ct, **R**eject, **T**ransform). In the **A**ct step, we come in contact with an issue and allow it take on a face. To do this, we will have an experience of

poverty in a simulation run by the Hunger Task Force. If this sounds intriguing, just stop by either night and pay \$10 per household at the door.
